### **Registration Fees**

Considerable reduction has been made to the conference fees to make it sustainable, fair and support the conference preparations and infrastructure we will be providing all delegates.

The virtual registration fee is €100 for ENAI members, and €150 for ALL International Delegates and AED300 for UAE local delegates (all-inclusive of UAE Federal Tax Authority's 5% VAT).

- Presentation should be succinct and in English



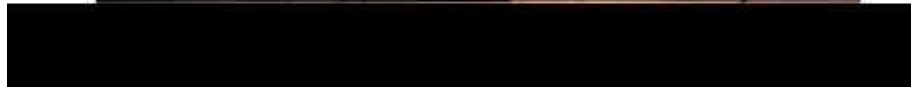
### Poster Instructions:

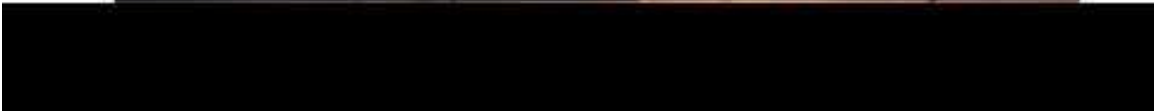

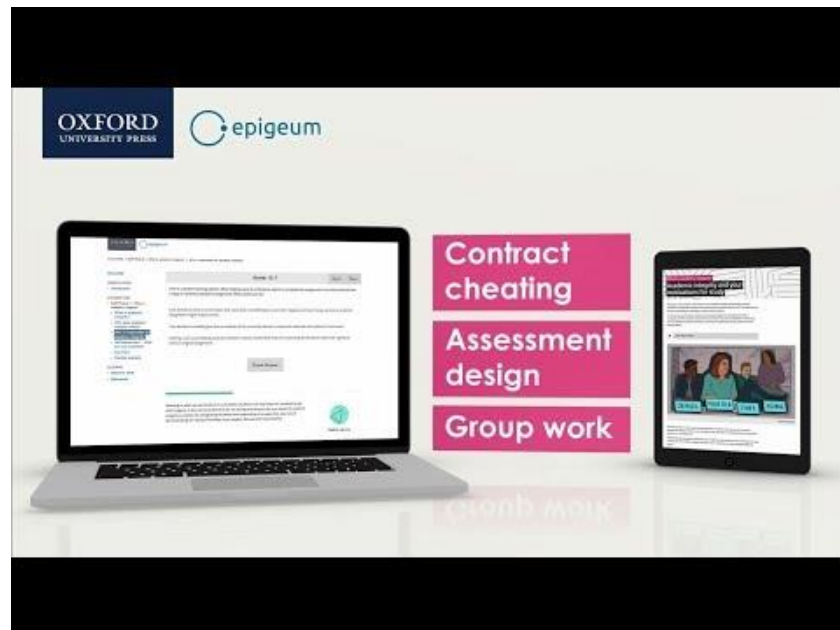
