

## Call for applications - Financial support for participants at the European Conference on Ethics and Integrity in Academia 2023 (ECEIA 2023)

A limited amount of financial support from the Council of Europe will be available for

1. ETINED delegates
2. Students, early career researchers from Albania, Andorra, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Holy See, Kazakhstan, Monaco, Montenegro, Republic of Moldova, San Marino, Turkey and Ukraine and who are unable to participate in the conference without receiving this support.

ENAI especially welcomes applicants from countries that have not previously been represented at the European Conference on Ethics and Integrity in Academia Conferences. The financial support will cover the conference fee and a three-day stay in a single room at the conference hotel. An additional amount of €250 will also be provided for each selected applicant to contribute to their travel expenses.

The identities of the applicants will be kept confidential and only the names of the selected applicants will be announced publicly on the conference website. Please see the Evaluation Rubric below for details of the selection criteria. To ensure transparency in the selection of the winners, all the applicants will be emailed individually by May 15, 2023 regarding their scores based on the Evaluation Rubric.

The applicants must provide the following information in **two pdf documents**:



- A letter of application explaining:
  - The applicant's motivation to participate in the conference.
  - The predicted budget plan with details of travel expenses (Please note that the financial support covers travel expenses up to €250 + the cost of registration including a three-day stay in a single room at the conference hotel).
  - The applicant's proposed post-conference contributions to the dissemination of the results presented at the conference, ENAI activities and ETINED values in their own region.
- A CV detailing the applicant's research or practitioner profile including, but not limited to, the background regarding education, employment, professional memberships, and publications.

All applications must be emailed to [conference@academicintegrity.eu](mailto:conference@academicintegrity.eu) with attached pdf documents containing the aforementioned information during the first call for proposals, to arrive no later than **April 30, 2023**.
