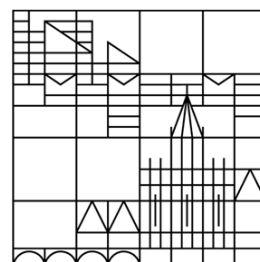

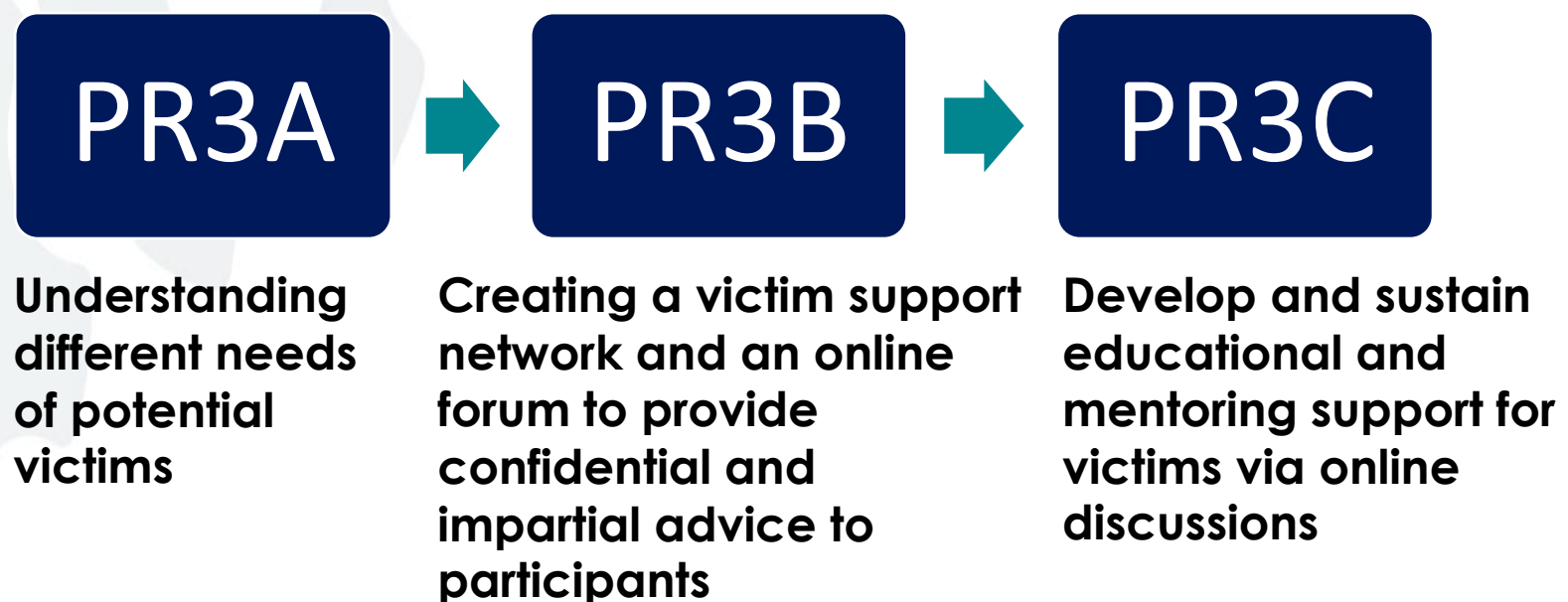
## *Project Result 3:*

# A support for victims of academic misconduct: an interactive portal and support network



PR3 will establish a confidential support network and provide an advisory service for people affected by unethical academic conduct using a secure interactive web portal. We aim to provide impartial and personal advice to all stakeholders who are affected by unethical practices.

We will follow a systematic approach from understanding the needs of potential beneficiaries to providing general assistance or specific advice for those who are affected by different forms of unethical practices via discussion forums.



# PR3A: Understanding different needs of potential victims



Under the coordination of ENAI, all partners will be involved in developing the online questionnaires and encouraging their institutional contacts and communities to complete the relevant versions. The partners participating in PR3 will lead this research by collating all available evidence, including data about previous requests for support and the literature review.

# PR3B: Creating a victim support network and an online forum to provide confidential and impartial advice to participants



We will use our joint staff training events to establish the list and have online meetings to ensure delivery.

The FAQs will be translated into the languages of participating partner countries. ENAI and University of Maribor will be responsible for creating the online forum for victim support. All partners will test this online forum and help to create the online platform. ENAI will ensure the sustainability of the portal after the end of the project.

# PR3C: Develop and sustain educational and mentoring support for victims via online discussions



We have already established a clear need for a support network. The participating partners are committed to operate this service during the project and we will continue to run this beyond the Project period. We will use the project period to publicise these platforms to all stakeholders via our multiplier events. Once the online forum is set up, people with experience in counselling and mentoring expertise within FAITH partners will provide confidential and impartial advice.

This support network will continue to conduct research on innovative methods and support people facing a range of different problems, caused by inappropriate actions of other people. Findings from this research will be published to create awareness of the problems faced by victims of academic dishonesty and what should be done to resolve such problems.
